AFFIDAVIT OF BETH BOGAERTS

1. My name is Beth Bogaerts. The subpoena issued by plaintiff to Twitter seeks to obtain information from my Twitter account.

2. At one time, I took the side of plaintiff Trevor Fitzgibbon in his controversy with Jesselyn Radack. However, I came to question his position, and stopped supporting him.

3. After I had this falling out with Trevor Fitzgibbon, I began receiving vile and threatening Twitter messages from Twitter users who were taking his side in the controversy. Some of these messages threatened to kill me, or urged me to kill myself.

4. I was terrified, and remain terrified, not only for myself but also for my husband and children.

5. To distance myself and my family from these threatening people, I have joined my husband in moving far away. Trevor Fitzgibbon knew where I lived when I was supporting him, but so far as I know, he does not know where I am now. I am worried that if the subpoena succeeds in securing my address or even the general location of my current residence, which could be revealed

by the Internet Protocol addresses from which I access Twitter, I could be subjected to threats or assault in person.
