4. The material facts constituting probable cause that the search should be made are:

On 9/11/2020, a group of protesters, identifying themselves as Free Them All VA, were encountered in the 400 block of S. King St. Members of this group had painted lettering on the sidewalk, which is owned by the Town of Leesburg, in blue paint. This paint was determined to be permanent and had to be professionally removed. The cost to repair the sidewalk to its original state is under \$1000. During the course of this investigation, it was learned that the Facebook username: FreeThemAllVA had videos and pictures of this destruction and those involved in committing the destruction. Since notification of this investigation was made public, the username: FreeThemAllVA has removed the images from at least public view. The requested information will assist in potentially determining who is responsible for this offense.
